Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri Biplab Kumar Deb, flagged off a consignment of 1000 kg "**Queen Pineapple**" today at the Horticulture Research Centre, Nagicherra, near Agartala for being exported abroad to Dubai.

The pineapples were procured by the Tripura Horticulture Corporation Limited (THCL), a Government of Tripura undertaking from farmers of remote Rangichera village of Kamalpur Subdivision of Dhalai District. The THCL has bought these pineapples at rates over and above the existing market rates in Tripura. The trans-shipment is being done by the Air-Cargo for which the State Government had recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Spicejet Airlines.

Speaking on this occasion, Hon'ble Chief Minister mentioned that the first consignment being exported is just the beginning and the State Government will make all the efforts to further enhance the income of the poor and tribal farmers of the State within short period of time by promoting production of Pineapple and Bamboo in the State of Tripura.

He said that this is one step further towards achievement of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's dream to reform the eight North-Eastern states into **'Ashta Laxmi'** by making them economically self sufficient and engines of growth in near future. He also asserted that Prime Minister's Shri Narendra Modi's vision of doubling the income of farmers by the year 2022 is an integral part of his Government's vision of **'Transforming Tripura'**.
