

Agartala Government Medical College & Govind Ballabh Pant Hospital

The first Medical College of the State was established in the sprawling campus of Govind Ballabh Pant Hospital campus using it as its Teaching Hospital of the College. It is affiliated to the Tripura University and has 100 intake capacity. Already 200 students are undergoing MBBS course. The admission is done from the merit list of Tripura Joint Entrance Examination and as per the guideline of Medical Council of India (MCI) maintaining reservation criteria of the state Government.

A master plan has been prepared for a new 5- storied Medical College Building along with six multistoried Hostels, multistoried staff Quarters, Auditorium, Gymnasium, Play ground Incinerator and other ancillary facilities at a cost of Rs. 146.95 crores (approximately).

The project has been assigned to M/S Larsen & Turbo Ltd.(L& T), a reputed construction agency of the country under the supervision of State PWD. Two floors of the New College building, four floors of the Boys' Hostel, Autopsy Block, Animal House and Gymnasium have already been made operational. Once construction of the new Medical College building is completed, the existing building (SS Block) where the College has been started initially would be converted into a part of the teaching hospital to meet the requirement of MCI. It is expected that the project would be completed by middle of 2008. All efforts are being made to make this College as a Center of Excellence.

In the year 2006-07 total 2,9,329 patients were treated in the IPD & total 1,92,404 patients were treated at OPD. Total nos. of X-Ray 3180, USG 467, CT Scan 572, Echocardiography 1190, ECG 7039, Pace maker implementation 46, Endoscopies 1269 & MRI 618 are done. Total 5234 Major & 8413 minor operations are conducted.

IGM Hospital

Former Victoria Memorial Hospital has been renamed as I. G. M. Hospital. Now-a-days, the I.G.M. Hospital is functioning as Civil Hospital of the State of Tripura.

In I. G. M. Hospital, full fledged services provided which are : Maternity, Obstetrics, Paediatrics, Medicines, Surgical, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, E.N.T., Dental, Blood Bank, Pathology, Radiology, Immunization, A.R.V., P.M.R etc.

Besides these during the Year 2006-2007 one Radiological Unit in the Private Section has been set up for extending X-Ray, USG & Scan and one Eye Bank is established. Apart from these for 24 hours of services one Emergency Medical Block has been set up at I.G.M. Hospital.

In the year 2006-07 in this Hospital total OPD patients were 2,76,580 & total indoor patients were 33,840. Total 8,121 nos. deliveries were conducted out of which caesarian section was 2,652.

CANCER Hospital

1. Under District Cancer Control Programme Colposcope and other instruments are purchased for early detection.
2. Brachytherapy OT Construction on Progress. C-Arm X - ray Machine and other equipments are already purchased.
3. NCRP (ICMR) WHO Project on "Development of an Atlas of Cancer in India" with data collection through website is going on at Cancer Hospital. Population Based cancer Registry (PBCR) named as Tripura Cancer Registry started functioning from January 2006.

4. Radiation safety Cell established under guidance of Bhaba Atomic Research Centre, Mumbai. For protection of people from hazardous effect of radiation.
5. Bhabatron Teletherapy Machine Installation Project Rs. 180 Lakhs and Microelectron HDR Brachy Therapy Machine Installation project Rs. 75 Lakhs are on the process.

5. Under DCCP Cancer Awareness Programme at Dharmanagar on 22.08.2006 has been organized.



6. Mass Cancer Awareness Campaign from Kumarghat Health Fair w.e.f. 20.04.2006 to 23.4.2006 and children park Agartala from 22.01.07 to 25.01.07
7. Three nurses were trained in Oncology for 3 months in Tata Memorial Hospital w.e.f June to August '06.

Rajib Gandhi Memorial Hospital

R.G.M. Hospital, being the referral Hospital of North Tripura District has been catering service in both curatives and preventive aspects. 14 Nos of Health Camps, 10 nos of eye camp, one Mega Surgical Camp were organized during 2006-07. A diabetic Clinic has been set up which runs twice a week.

3 Air conditioners were installed in 3 cabins. ECG done to 115 patients and USG to 608 Patients, 534 Children received full course of DPT and OPV, 655 Children received BCG and 447 children received measles vaccine, 306 Children received DT, 553 Pregnant mother received TT injection. 345 Nos of Cataract operation done.

483 Nos of obstetrical case 188 nos. of surgery orthopedic and ENT cases were operated. JSY benefit was given to 216 Nos. Patients. Total No. of IPD Patients was 3685 and OPD patients was 21,228. A new OPD Complex taken up for construction is on the verge of completion.

Tripura Sundari District Hospital

In the referral hospital of the South Tripura District, Tripura Sundari District Hospital, the services available are Medicine, Surgery including Obstetric & Gynaecology, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, Paediatric, Psychiatric, Skin, VD, RTI, STI, Pathology, Microbiology, Bio-Chemistry, Radiology & Imaging, ECG etc. In the Year 2006-07 1,11,815 patients were attended in the OPD.

33,186 patients were admitted in the IPD. 2,903 deliveries have been conducted. 15,903 nos. pathological tests have been done, X-Ray 5,228 nos, Ultra sonography 537 nos. have been conducted. Total 231 L. L. operations have been done.

Apart from these 291 nos mothers have got benefit of Janani Surakha Yojana. Routine immunization Programme, Blindness Control Programme, Family Welfare Programme etc. have also been carried out.
