NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to the Article-309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the post of **Extension Officer (Industries), Group-C (Non-Gazetted)**, the Governor is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Extension Officer (Industries), Group-C (Non-Gazetted)** in the Department of Industries & Commerce, Govt. of Tripura.

1. Short title Commencement :-

- a. These rules may be called the revised Recruitment Rules, 2025 for the post of **Extension Officer (Industries)** under the Department of Industries & Commerce, Govt. of Tripura.
- b. They shall come in to force on and from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. The name of the post(s) shall be as specified in Column- 1 of the scheduled enclosed.

3. Number, Classification and scale of pay .

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be specified in column no. **2 to 4** of the **Schedule enclosed at Annexure -III.**

4. Method of Recruitments, age limit, qualification etc.

The method of recruitment to the posts, age limits, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Column No. **5 to 13** of the said scheduled.

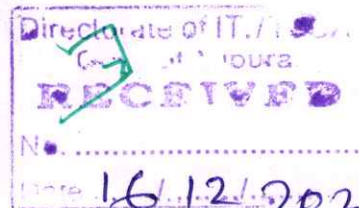
5. Disqualification:-No person.

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living;

or

- b. who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.



6. **Power to relax** :-Where the State Government if of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do , it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded on the writing, and in consultation with the GA(P&T) Department and concurrence of the Finance Department, Govt. of Tripura, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Repeal** :- The Recruitments Rules for the aforementioned posts existing in this Department are hereby repealed with immediate effect and are replaced by these Recruitment Rules according to the Schedule at Annexure - III enclosed herewith.
8. **Savings** :- Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex- Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the state Government from time to time in this regard.
9. This Notification is issued as per Notification No.20(1)-GA(P&T)/18, dated 5th June,2018 and Memorandum No.20(1)-GA(P&T)/18, dated 2nd Jan,2021 issued by the GA(P&T) Department, Government of Tripura.

ANNEXURE -A**SYLLABUS FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT OF EXTENSION OFFICER (INDUSTRIES), GROUP-'C', NON-GAZETTED UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIES AND COMMERCE, GOVT. OF TRIPURA**

The Examination will comprise of two successive stages viz. (i) Written Examination (Multiple Choice Type Test) carrying 85 marks and (ii) An Interview cum Personality Test carrying 15 marks.

(A) Scheme of the Written Examination: The Written Examination will consist of one paper viz. a paper on General Knowledge - World, India, Tripura, General English, Basic Mathematical Abilities, Aptitude and Job Oriented Knowledge. The paper will be of an Objective Type consisting of 85 Multiple- Choice Question (MCQ). The paper will carry 85 marks and will be of Two and a half (2½) hours duration. There will be Negative marks for MCQ. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, one-fourth of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.

(a) Primary Merit list will be prepared by adding marks obtained in all papers of the written examination restrict the number of candidates to be called interview. Number of candidates (Category wise) in the written Examination shall be called for Interview in the following ratio subject to attaining of minimum qualifying marks in the written examination (40% of Un-Reserved candidates and 35% o for reserved category candidates.

1(one)	05 (Five) candidates (1:5)
2(two)	08(eight) candidates (1:4)
03(three) and above	3(three) times the number of vacancies (1:3)

Note :- Candidates(s) scoring marks equal to that of the last candidate so selected for the Interview will also be called for Interview.

(b) Final Merit list will be prepared by adding the marks obtained in the written examination and Interview. In no case a candidate will be called for Interview unless he/she appears of the Written Examination. If a candidate remain absent in Interview, his/her candidature will not be considered for final selection.
