

**Media Bulletin on COVID 19, Dated:02.10.2020 Evening**

World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as Pandemic. Till now it has affected many countries/areas/territories, confirmed cases **3,40,79,542** people and caused **10,15,963** deaths. (source: - <https://covid19.who.int/> at 6.00 pm)

Till date in India, the Confirmed Cases are **63,94,068** (+81,484), **recovered 53,52,078** (+78,877) including **99,773** (+1,095) **deaths**. The situation of Confirmed COVID-19 cases in North Eastern states: - Assam (**1,82,396**), Meghalaya (**5,802**), Manipur (**11,111**), Nagaland (**6,244**), Mizoram (**2,049**), Arunachal Pradesh (**10,020**), Sikkim (**3,050**). Till date in Tripura Active Cases are **5,176** and recovered **20,874**.
