Terms of References for Hiring of Technical Support Agency (TSA) for developing piggery value chain with 6000 women SHG members in 3 project districts of Tripura under TRLM

1.0 Background

Pigs are the most common and preferred livestock species in Tripura and reared by the weaker section of the total population particularly in the rural and hilly areas. Piggery itself contributes 30-35% of the total meat production in the state.¹ Traditionally, the tribal populations are rearing pigs. Besides, the non-tribal has now been taken up pig farming as primary source of income. The majority of tribal households rear pigs (mostly 1 or 2 pigs), mainly for fattening purposes as a good source of animal origin protein. Pig rearing occupies an important position in the farming system in Tripura as it is closely interlinked with the other agricultural operation performed by the tribal people for livelihood. The production system in the villages is very traditional, mainly based on indigenous local pigs with feeding systems primarily based on jungle forages and kitchen waste. Feeding of balanced concentrate feed to pigs is popular now days, the concentrates readily available in the market. Some farmers buy a couple of feed ingredients, maize, wheat bran or rice polish, from the local feed stall and fed it to pigs with any additional farm and kitchen waste. However, they hardly buy any protein rich feed ingredients or mineral and vitamin mixture. This is possibly because pig producers lack knowledge of pig nutrition together with financial constraints. These traditional feeds provide inadequate nutrition to support acceptable growth rates and maintain good health. In addition collecting forages is a major cause of forest degradation. Also, collection of forages and fuel wood places an enormous burden on women who are traditionally responsible for these activities.

Pigs reared in villages are of mixed breed and pure breeds are almost impossible to locate. Villagers procure piglets locally. Households in the villages find it difficult to provide feed due to which pig rearing is confined to backyard activity with 1-2 pigs. Pigs are slaughtered by the households itself for self-consumption, mostly during festivals. Sales are reared and take place only to meet financial exigencies. Excess pork is sold at the rate of Rs 350-400/Kg among the villagers by the households directly.

Piggery in Tripura is become a profitable commercial venture particularly for the women of the Self Help Group from small holder farming community. This, however, will require creating awareness and provide technical support for producing quality piglet, improve the production system and marketing system.

Looking the potential of Piggery as a livelihood of SHG women of the tribal communities of TRLM project area, TRLM is planning to develop the piggery value chain in 3 project district with the following broad objective-

To developed 7 pig production clusters with total 6,000 farmers in 3 project districts of TRLM to increase the pig production of the SHG women by 50% at the end of 3 years project period. Thus double the farmers' income of the pig farmers at the end of 3 years.

2.0 Scope of Work:

- To build the technical capacity of the 6,000 SHG women on improved pig rearing practices so that the production can be increased by 50 percent at the end of 3 years project duration
- Develop at least 100 mother unit as quality pig breading unit which can supply quality piglets to the pig fattening farmers.
- Build capacity of more than 100 livestock CRPs on improved pig rearing and breeding practices so that they can provide quality services to SHG women related to this
- Build capacity of the Livelihood Coordinator (Livestock) of TRLM so that they can be effectively support in the pig production cluster
- Promote at least 60 pig producer groups at the village level with an average annual turnover of 20-50 Lakhs from input and output business at the end of 3 years
- Support in connecting the piggery producers and PGs with existing FPOs of TRLM in the project district
- Provide technical support in ensuring on time vaccination, insurance and other critical issues
- Develop business plan for all the PGs promoted under this value chain development work.
