

The Tripura Housing Board Act, 1978

Section	Provision
48	<p>Penalty for contravention of bye-law Whoever contravenes a bye-law made under section 47 shall, on conviction be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees or with both.</p>
49	<p>If any person (a) obstructs, or molests any person with whom the Board has entered into a contract, in the performance or execution of his duty or of anything which he is empowered or required to do under this Act, or (b) removes any mark set up for the purpose of indicating any level or direction necessary to the execution of works authorized under this Act, he shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months or with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees or with both.</p>
50	<p>Authority for prosecution Unless otherwise expressly provided, no Court shall take cognizance of any offence punishable, under this Act except on the complaint of, or upon information received from, the Board or some person authorized by the Board by general or special order in this behalf.</p>
