

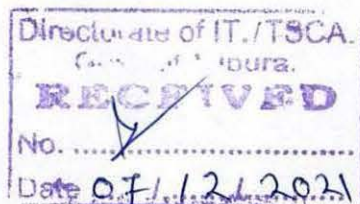



With reference to the cited subject, I have the honour to refer to the letter F.No.12017/01/2021-TNP(S) dated August 19, 2021 from the Department of Personnel and Training, Govt. of India (DoPT) vide which approval has been accorded for conducting 3-day Online In-service Training Programme on "Futuristic Cities : Smart and Resilient" from January 17, 2022 to January 19, 2022 at HUDCO's HSMI, New Delhi.

FUTURISTIC CITIES – SMART AND RESILIENT****BACKGROUND - HUDCO's HSMI**

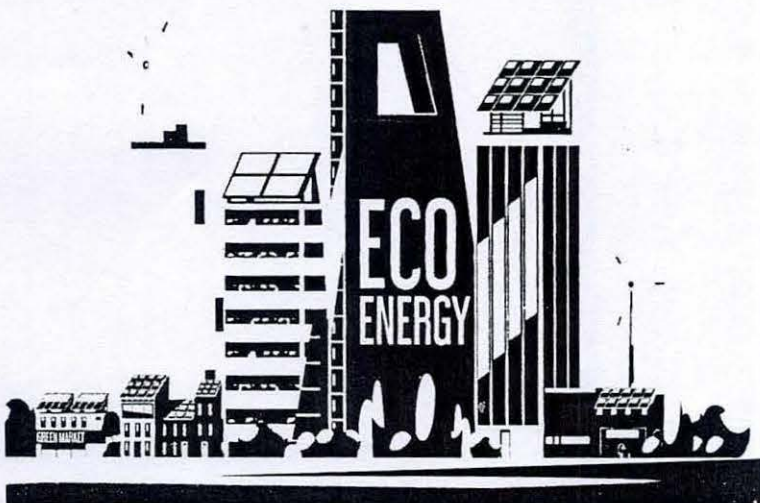

About 1/3rd of the Indian population lives in urban areas and this trend is going to see a surge in the coming years. Cities are the pivotal centres for economic growth, employment creation, innovative and cultural exchange. However, cities are also places where problems of poverty, unemployment & inequality and associated ills like homelessness, traffic snarls, water scarcity, open defecation and air pollution are prevalent. These problems are going to magnify much more in the years ahead with increased inflow of population into cities and extreme weather events linked to global climate change like flooding, tropical cyclones, heat waves and epidemics. The traditional models of urban development that one has been following if perpetuated further would lock us into congestion, sprawl and inefficient resource use. Sustainable, resilient and smart growth where buildings and infrastructure systems are resource efficient would create city level systems that are futuristic and adaptive to future demands.

Being a national level training institution in the country, the MoHUA has instructed HSMI to impart training on various issues related to housing and urban development. Keeping such challenges in mind, HUDCO's HSMI is organizing a Training Programme on 'Futuristic Cities – Smart and Resilient'.


General Guidelines/Instructions/Information for In- Service Training Programmes (Offline/Physical) and 3-5 day Online In-Service Training Programmes for AIS Officers (IAS, IPS & IFoS), officers working under the Central Staffing Scheme, Central Secretariat Service (CSS) and Central Secretariat Stenographers Service (CSSS) Officers.

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The following general guidelines/instructions/information with regard to One-Week In-Service Training Programmes (Offline/Physical) and 3-5 day Online In-Service Training Programme for the year 2021-22 for AIS (IAS, IPS & IFoS) Officers, Officers working under the Central Staffing Scheme and Central Secretariat Service (CSS) and Central Secretariat Stenographers Service (CSSS) Officers (of the level of DS/Sr. PPS and above)

1. **Eligibility:**

- (a) AIS (IAS, IPS & IFoS) Officers;
 - (b) Officers working under the Central Staffing Scheme in the Government of India with minimum of 4 years of Service up-to the rank of Secretary to the Govt. of India and Chief Secretary in the State Govt. and equivalent;
 - (c) Central Secretariat Service (CSS) and Central Secretariat Stenographers Service (CSSS) Officers of the level DS/ Sr. PPS and above.
2. All the training programmes (Offline/Physical Mode) are residential in nature. Accommodation facilities will be provided to the participants by the training institutes who are organizing the training programme.
 3. The 3-5-day Online Training Programmes are attended through virtual mode. These programmes are not residential programmes.
 4. The IAS officers are required to apply on-line through the Intra IAS portal. All other Officers are required to apply through the prescribed proforma available with these guidelines after obtaining approval of the Competent Authority of the Department/ Ministry/ State Government/ Cadre controlling authority concerned.
 5. The Officers who are due for retirement may not be sponsored for the training programme scheduled in the month in which they are due to retire.
 6. The Officers posted abroad are exempted from participation in the programme and their applications will not be considered.
 7. The Officers are not allowed to apply or change options within 10 days of the commencement of an opted programme.
 8. The Officers can attend only one In-Service Training Programme either Physically OR online during the financial year 2021-22.
 9. The minimum no. of participants may not be less than 15 and the maximum no. may not exceed 40 to ensure economic viability and optimal utilization of training programs for better career prospects.
